- green = $\frac{3}{4}$ of all the territory
- population: 290k; 1,053/km²
- 542 m² of public green area per inhabitant
- 4 landscape parks (14% of surface)
- 50.000 trees in GIS




- forest area -> 40%



- Supporting multi-purpose use of UPF and exploiting new sustainable development opportunities




- In the 15th century fruit trees, vineyards and forests were planted

Landscape park Tivoli, Rožnik and Šiška hill















- Total area -> 459 ha (y. 2015)

- Rich cultural heritage






- Restoratoin of historic tree avenue on a private land for long-term protection of the *Osmoderma eremita* (beetle) population
- removal of woody plants that overgrew the Mali Rožnik nature reserve (different private landowners);
- Cooperation with RS and adjacent private landowners for restoring degraded informal trail
- Assembly of landowners (end of year 2018)
