Getting stakeholders involved


Degree of participation

Information (one-way communication)

To be informed Example: brochures, letters, media releases, websites, exhibition etc.

Consultation
(active and mutual
communication)To be heard
To think together
To join a conversation
Example: statements, questionaires, fora, blogs,
open councils

Representative Participation in decision making (cooperation, intense communication) To express reccommendations to decion makers To decide together To implement together Example: "future"-conferences, transdisciplinary work, mediation in the public sector
