



Map of Bahrain, 1960. Charles Belgrave, Personal Column (London: Hutchinson, 1960).




Satellite image of the Arabian peninsula, March 2000. Bahrain is the small island in the center, adjacent to the larger peninsula of Qatar.




Map of Bahrain, 1963. Note areas of greenery on the north and west coasts.


